Dear friends,

Happy Easter to you all! We hope that you managed to celebrate the Easter Triduum in some fitting way, either virtually or in person. The Easter season is the high point of the church's year and it is filled with a message of hope.

On Good Friday, in a stark and almost empty St. Peter's Square, Pope Francis led the Stations of the Cross. This year, these reflections were written by children and young people. They related the 'Way of the Cross' and the experience of Jesus to their own experiences. Their insight and depth of faith was inspirational! One child's prayer was as beautiful and simple as this... "We thank you, Jesus, for having given us, by your death on the cross, the power of hope."



By now, you will know that our Archdiocesan Pilgrimage has, once again, been postponed due to COVID-19. This was not an easy decision, but it was one which was taken with everyone's best interest at heart - not least our dedicated Medical Team who continue to give so much of themselves in their various roles within the NHS. We continue to keep all of them in our prayers.

Throughout the year, since our 2020 Pilgrimage did not go ahead, both the Hospitalité and Pilgrimage Committees have worked hard to ensure that the 'Lourdes Connection' continues and that the Spirit of Lourdes is alive within our Archdiocese. 
